The offertory collection for St Leo's was **£164.46**. For St Luke's it was **£373.87**.

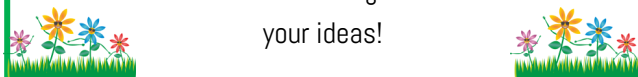
